


GridFTP Working Group Status



What has been done

- GridFTP v1.0 protocol document has been submitted for public review
- Web site was created, started moving to GridForge
- Between GGF7 and GGF8 we had discussion of GridFTP features and issues in the mailing list
 - Summary was published on newly created web site
- During WG meeting on Tuesday we finalized the list of desired GridFTP improvements
 - Most of the items are concrete issues with one or two known solutions to choose from
 - Some items are more like topics of research and discussions



Plans for future

- Shortly after GGF8 submit GGF document with analysis of GridFTP v1.0 features and list of improvements
- Between GGF8 and GGF9 discuss each issue on the list and
 - Find and discuss alternative solutions
 - Choose solutions
- By GGF9 have concrete list of proposed protocol modifications, discuss it during GGF9
- Between GGF8 and GGF10 prototype proposed/approved solutions
- GGF10 - approve v2.0 of GridFTP protocol
